Study Program in Europe Sweden 2008-2013

The University of Manitoba's Department of Agribusiness and Agricultural Economics has negotiated a bilateral exchange agreement with the Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (SLU), whereby students from the University of Manitoba may take 1 semester of study at SLU, generally at the main campus in Uppsala (Ultuna) or, in certain specialized instances, another of the satellite campuses in Sweden.

- This program is open to a limited number of senior students in the Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences, or the Department of Landscape Architecture at the University of Manitoba.
- Initially, students should indicate their interest in the exchange program by letter to Dr. Gary Johnson, Department of Agribusiness and Agricultural Economics, Room 379 - 66 Dafoe Road (Faculty of Agricultural and Food Sciences Building), including provision of information regarding their academic background and areas of interest.
- The Exchange Programs Assistant in the Department of Agribusiness and Agricultural Economics will assist accepted students apply for a Letter of Permission from the University of Manitoba. Students will pay tuition fees at the University of Manitoba and receive credit toward their degree.
- Please note: Interested students should prepare well in advance. The Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences deadlines for receipt of completed applications is April 15 for the September session and October 15 for the January session.
- Accessing the SLU website, www.slu.se/page.cfm?page=306 will provide some background information for exchange students, a current course guide and the application forms. The Exchange Programs Assistant will help accepted exchange students to complete the forms, which will then be sent by courier to SLU, together with the required attachments.
