### CFA READINESS

The Asper MFin offers a degree-based curriculum centred on the Chartered Financial Analyst Institute program. Nearly 85% of the CFA Candidate Body of Knowledge is mapped into the curriculum.



Students can take the program part-time, or at an accelerated pace of one year, over three terms, making it the shortest program duration in Canada for similar programs.



Asper is home to the state-of-the-art CIBC Business Intelligence Centre. The core of the Centre consists of 23 Bloomberg terminals, which are equipped with one of the world's leading financial knowledge tools. The Centre gives students access to the latest financial data and the ability to complete projects that focus on real-life business decisions, helping to bridge business theory with practice.





#### **EXPECTED DURATION**

One to four years consisting of three 12-week terms, running from August to December, January to April, and May to August.
