# Resources for writing an Artist CV

### Resume or CV?

**Artist CV**: record of all your professional activities, usually intended for use in academic situations as well as for applications to employment opportunities. Best used for M.F.A. graduates and the experienced artist.

**Artist Resume:** abbreviated document, typically shorter in length, and is often tailored to reflect a specific expertise. For artist seeking entry level jobs, residencies, grant applications, public art proposals, and non-profit gallery exhibitions. Best for recent B.F.A graduates who are building their professional experience and applying for entry-level artist positions.

# Tip:

Ensure that the CV's design aesthetic matches the job you are applying for. For creative roles, CVs with a touch of color may be preferred. For more corporate roles, go for a more simple design.
