Selection Process: The Scholarship Committee's decision will be forwarded to the University of Manitoba's Financial Aid and Awards Office. Students will be notified by the University of Manitoba, and the scholarship will be credited to the student's tuition fees by the University of Manitoba. Award certificates will be presented to recipients at the College Convocation on the first Sunday in November.
