LORRAINE CHAMBERLAIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP IN EDUCATION

A fund has been established at The University of Manitoba from the bequest of Donna Lorraine Chamberlain to provide annual scholarships in the Faculty of Education. The Manitoba Scholarships and Bursaries Initiative has made a contribution to this fund. Each year, a scholarship is to be offered to the student entering the Faculty of Education with the highest academic standing previous to studying education. This scholarship is renewable, in that the first winner is to receive the scholarship for each year that he or she may be enrolled with a full course-load (minimum 80 percent with extenuating circumstances) in the Bachelor of Education degree program. The intent of the fund is to support the chosen students for each year of the program, "regardless of their academic performance during the program".

The value of the individual scholarships will vary from year to year, as the available annual income is to be divided evenly between all award recipients for that year (the new, entering recipient and those who are renewing the award).

Requests for deferrals or renewals will be considered by the appropriate body.

The selection committee for this scholarship is to be named by the Director of Financial Aid and Awards in consultation with the Dean of Education.
