MARGE AND MEL GUNSON MEMORIAL AWARD

An endowment fund has been established at the University of Manitoba in memory of Mel and Marge Gunson, who both received Bachelor of Education degrees from the University of Manitoba. Mel was a teacher and school principal in the Fort Garry School Division for most of his career and held the position of President of the Manitoba Association of Principals and Vice-Principals. Marge taught in the Norwood School Division for most of her career. The award, valued at the available annual interest, will be offered for the first time for the 2006-2007 academic session to a student who:

- (1) is enrolled full-time (80% course load) in the second year of study in the Faculty of Education at the University of Manitoba;
- (2) has achieved a minimum sessional grade point average of 3.0 based on their first year of study (minimum 80% course load); and
- (3) has indicated an intention to work after graduation as a school teacher in Manitoba.

Applicants will be required to submit a statement (maximum 250 words) outlining where they hope to teach after graduation.

The selection committee will be named by the Associate Dean (Undergraduate Programs) of the Faculty of Education.
