Sara and Nathan Wolk Award Fund

The Sara and Nathan Wolk Award Fund has been established at The Jewish Foundation of Manitoba, to provide one or two annual bursaries to support students in the Faculty of Education at the University of Manitoba. The value of the bursary or bursaries shall be determined by The Jewish Foundation of Manitoba based on the annual income from the fund and shall be reported to the Financial Aid and Awards Office each year.

One or two bursaries, of equal value, will be offered to undergraduate students who:

- (1) are enrolled full-time in the Faculty of Education in the Bachelor of Education degree (including Weekend College), the Bachelor of Music/Bachelor of Education Integrated degree, or the Bachelor of Human Ecology/Bachelor of Education Integrated degree program;
- (2) have achieved a minimum degree grade point average of 3.0;
- (3) have demonstrated commitment to the community;
- (4) have demonstrated financial need on the standard University of Manitoba bursary application form.

Equal consideration will be given to academic excellence, community service, and financial need.

Candidates must complete and submit a bursary application form describing the details of their community service.

The selection committee shall be named by the Associate Dean (Undergraduate Programs) of the Faculty of Education.
