

Faculty of Education Graduate Student Research Award Guidelines

Purpose: To support Faculty of Education graduate students' thesis-related research projects.

Eligibility: Current part-time and full-time Education graduate students are eligible if they:

are in good academic standing in their program;

- have successfully defended their thesis proposal within the last twelve (12) months;
- do not hold any major research funding awards (e.g., SSHRC, UMGF, etc.)

Value: The value of the award is up to \$1,000

Application Process and Deadlines:

- rolling application deadline
- student must submit the following documentation:
 - a completed application form;
 - a signed copy of thesis proposal defence report form;
 - a letter of support from the student's program advisor submitted directly by the referee to adgr.education@umanitoba.ca

Evaluation Criteria

Applications to this Award will be reviewed by the Associate Dean, Graduate Programs & Research based on the following criteria:

- the quality of the research proposal
- statement of support from the student's advisor
- a completed application

Conditions of the Award

- research supported by the Graduate Student Research Award must comply with the University policies on the conduct of research, specifically the University policies on research ethics
- funds must be used to support the research project and for the purposes described in the application
- students can access this award only once during their program of studies
- within three months of successful completion of the final thesis defence, students must submit a report to the Associate Dean, Graduate Programs & Research. This report should not exceed one page and should describe: what was accomplished; a summary of any research findings; plans for research dissemination; and plans for future research, if applicable
- students are encouraged to present their thesis findings at the annual Faculty of Education Graduate Students'
 Research Symposium
