- Students with an interest in the Conversation and Biodiversity Focus Area (or other Focus Areas including advanced Biology courses) are advised to complete the combination of BIOL 1020 and BIOL 1030 as well as BIOL 2300 (or AGECE 2370) instead of BIOL 1010 and BIOL 2390.
- The former ENVR 2650 may be used in lieu of ENVR3160.
- Students must complete 3 cr.hrs. of course work containing significant international content. Students are referred to List B for a list of available courses (ABIZ 1010, ECON 2550, ECON 3670, GEOG 4260, POLS 3250 / 2040 / 3220). Students may substitute with another course as approved by the student advisor.
- The former GEOG 3680 may be used in lieu of GEOG3810.

- One of INDG 1220, INDG 1240, INDG 2020 or HIST 2020, INDG 2080.
