

THE PLATONIC TEXTUAL TRADITION: A BIBLIOGRAPHY

This bibliography was begun haphazardly as a by-product of my own research. Later I decided to compile it on a more systematic basis in the hope that it would be useful to others who are working on the Platonic textual tradition and that it might promote study in this field. - Abbreviations of periodicals are generally those used in *L'Année philologique*.
- Abbreviations of Platonic works are those given in LSJ.
- I identify *editiones principes* of papyri at the end of relevant entries by citing in parentheses the papyrus catalogue no. and the Platonic text which the papyrus contains.
- Editions of *Platonis opera omnia* which made original contributions to our knowledge of the textual tradition (Bekker, Stallbaum, Hermann, Schanz etc.) are cited, but only basic bibliographical information is given.
