#### **University Prep Week**

Diploma in Agriculture Program students will benefit from participating in this university event

#### **Expanded Orientation**

Three additional days of virtual programming will be delivered to prepare new students and build a learning community with members of the agricultural industry, FAFS and School communities

#### **October Field Trip Week**

Cancel 3 days of field trips and offer 1 day for virtual field trips/virtual community building activities. Courses that require a virtual field trip to meet essential learning outcomes can schedule time on October 14<sup>th</sup> or use existing lab and lecture slots for synchronous delivery or arrange for asynchronous delivery.

#### **Add Fall Term University Break**

Students and instructors will benefit from this when dealing with the challenges and stresses associated with virtual course delivery.

#### **Winter Term Field Trips**

#### **Academic Schedule Section 1.12**

#### **College of Rehabilitation Sciences – Occupational Therapy**

There has been a need for the Master of Occupational Therapy program to manage student fieldwork placements differently to deal with the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- OT 6400 Intermediate 1 Fieldwork, that was to offered in May-June 2020 for the 2021 cohort has been postponed to Fall Term 2020 (October 26-December 4, 2020), but the course has been reduced from 8 weeks to 6 weeks for this cohort only. The 2 weeks removed from OT 6400 will be added to OT 7800 Advanced Fieldwork in the 2021 Summer Term to ensure we can provide this cohort with as much in-person fieldwork as possible without delaying their program completion if we are unable to offer in-person placements for students in Fall 2020
- To ensure there is sufficient time to incorporate the additional 2 weeks in OT 7800, the start date has been adjusted (June 22-September 10, 2021). This further necessitates an adjustment to the start of Winter Term and the Winter Term break for this cohort.
- For the incoming class of 2022, we have decided to reduce OT 6200 Basic Fieldwork from 4 weeks to 3 weeks (November 30-December 18, 2020) for this cohort only. The 1 week removed from OT 6200, plus an additional week, will be added to OT 7800 Advanced Fieldwork in the 2022 Summer Term to ensure we can provide this cohort with as much in-person fieldwork as possible without delaying their program completion if we are unable to offer in-person placements for students in Fall 2020.
