3. Percentages may not add up to 100 due to rounding.

4. The "Pass Only" grades refer to Pass/Fail courses and are not included in the "Average Grade" calculations.

5. The averages are unweighted as to credit hours and are computed using the following scales: A+=4.5 A=4.0 B+=3.5 B=3.0 C+=2.5 C=2.0 D=1.0 F=0

6. A temporary revision to the Grade Point Average Policy was approved by Senate in response to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Under the revision, students may have certain grades excluded from their term GPA calculations. The average grade is based on only those grades included in GPA calculations.

7. The Faculty of Engineering changed its name to the Price Faculty of Engineering in 2020.
