1. The Manitoba Education and Training Department provides financial support toward the ACCESS programs. ACCESS programs enhance accessibility for priority groups consisting of northern Manitobans, Indigenous peoples, single parents, women, low-income earners, immigrants, refugees, visible minorities, and people with disabilities.
2. The reporting of degrees is based on a calendar year (February, May, and October graduands).
3. The COVID-19 pandemic had substantial impacts on the University of Manitoba in 2020, 2021, and 2022, with the impacts diminishing over the years that followed. Comparisons involving covid-affected years should be made with caution.
4. Program is exclusively for students of Indigenous ancestry.
