

INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENT UPDATE

Fall 2021

The University of Manitoba is moving to a new four course model for direct entry admissions. The new model requires all programs to include a grade 12 (senior level) Mathematics and English course in the admission average calculation. In addition, the new model features varying minimum course averages by program.

The new program-specific admission requirements effective for the Fall 2021 intake are listed in the table below. Any programs **not** listed in the table below remain unchanged for the Fall 2021 intake and will be changed no earlier than Fall 2022.

Please note that the general entrance requirements for all programs (high school graduation including five full courses at the senior level) will remain unchanged.
