**CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY**

**The Joe Brain Foundation Inc. Bursary is awarded on the basis of the following criteria:**

- preference will be given to a student who is a resident north of the 52<sup>nd</sup> parallel, in Manitoba, including Creighton, Sask.  
**AND/OR**
- **to a student pursuing a career in the following areas:**
  - Geology, Mining, Engineering, Geographical Studies
  - Medicine and Medical Research
  - Education and Community Service
- students must have GPA of 2.5 or higher
- must be full time undergraduate student
- must be a member of St. Paul's College
- student must demonstrate active participation within the College and/or the community in the areas of interest to St. Paul's College
- financial need represents 50% of the criteria and includes special financial circumstances
- financial need for Canadian students is determined by the assessment of need as provided by the Manitoba Student Financial Assistance Program: [www.studentaid.gov.mb.ca](http://www.studentaid.gov.mb.ca)
- and international students must fill out the Income and Expense Sheet posted online

\*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.
