CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

The **Diane Dowling Memorial Scholarship** is awarded to students on the basis of the following criteria:

- membership at St. Paul's College at time of application*
- have achieved high marks in one 6 credit hour or two 3 credit hour courses in Mathematics during second or third year studies at U. of M.
- have completed the second year of studies with a declared major/minor or honours in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics.

This scholarship is awarded in September at Opening Academic Exercises.

*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application must be received in the Dean's Office prior to or on **August 15** to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:30 p.m. the next business day.
