CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

The **Marilyn France Memorial Scholarship** is awarded to a 2nd or 3rd year student with a major or minor in English in the department of English, Film, and Theatre on the basis of the following criteria:

- Membership at St. Paul's College at time of application
- GPA of 3.5 or higher
- Undergraduate student
- Enrolled as a 2nd or 3rd year student at the University of Manitoba
- Major or minor is English literature
- Graduate of St. Mary's Academy
- Must submit summary of 250-words describing the value of academics and service
- Demonstrates active participation in the community service

This scholarship is awarded in January at St. Paul's Day.

*All University of Manitoba students are welcome to apply and to become members of the College by requesting their preference for membership via the Aurora system. Membership fee is \$19 per term.

APPLICATION DEADLINE

The application must be received in the Dean's Office prior to or on **September 30** to receive consideration. If the deadline falls on a weekend or holiday, it will be extended until 4:30 p.m. the next business day. You may submit the application by email to stpaulscollege@umanitoba.ca. Award recipients will be notified in advance and will receive their cheque at the St. Paul's Day Awards Ceremony in January.
