The ultimate and precision nutrient management is to use site specific data for your site specific recommendations. But having nutrient rate response studies scattered around your farm every year is just not feasible. This presentation will take the KISS (Keep It Simple Silly) approach to refining your nutrient management for both preplant and in-season decisions. Most farmers have seen addition or omission strips in the fields where either the fertilizer rig double up, or skipped. Learn how these strips are being used across the Great Plains to improve nutrient use efficiency and increase yields.
