#### **RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Play a key role in making Downtown a beautiful and welcoming place - this includes planting, maintaining, watering, weeding of flowers and vegetation in public spaces throughout the downtown area.
- Contribute to ongoing projects that improve and beautify public spaces in downtown Winnipeg including the upkeep and surveying of seasonal installations, site furnishings, and infrastructure conditions.
- Remove litter and debris on sidewalks, around bus shelters, and other public areas.
- Other duties as assigned including event set up and take down and infrastructure installation.
- Report any concerns and/or questions from BIZ Members or the public.

- Understanding of Safe Work procedures and practices.
