IMMEDIATE RETURNS

The Master of Supply Chain Management and Logistics program is the only program in Canada that has a built-in four-month practicum component that can be taken as an applied project or as a co-op. MENTORSHIP IN THE FIELD

Master of Supply Chain Management and Logistics students study and learn from professors working within the University of Manitoba Transport Institute, recognized for defining the future direction of and scholarly research in transportation, logistics and supply chain.



FLEXIBLE SCHEDULES

Students can keep their full-time work schedule while taking the program. Courses are offered evenings and weekends.

EXPECTED DURATION

Two to four years (includes a four-month co-op or applied project) consisting of three 10-week terms, running from August to December, January to April and May to July.

Full-time students are typically enrolled in three courses per term.

PROGRAM COSTS

Fees for Canadian citizens and Permanent Residents (subject to change):

Fees vary depending on how long a student takes to complete the program. Full-time duration is two years, and part-time duration is three to four years. The costs listed below are an estimate of tuition and associated fees.

Total Canadian tuition is \$29,300, plus a \$5,150 co-op or applied project fee, and an estimated \$2,000 of additional annual fees.

The payment schedule is listed at umanitoba.ca/registrar/tuition-fees/graduate

The total cost for textbooks in the degree is an estimated \$1,500.

A Tuition Sponsorship Application Form will be required prior to the fee payment deadline.
