MURDITH McLEAN SCHOLARSHIP

Application / Nomination Form

Criteria

- Residents of St John's College may apply or nominate other St John's College Residents for the scholarship based on the following criteria. The candidate:
- is entering the second or later year as a Resident student of St Johns College this fall;
 - is registered as a St John's College Member;
 - is registered as full-time student (minimum 18 credit hours) at the University of Manitoba,
 - has a cumulative average of at least a B (3.0 GPA);
 - best combines contributions to Residence life with academic achievement.

****Residence Dons and IEP students are not eligible to apply****

Instructions if you are applying

- Complete and sign the application / nomination form.
- Include a **single sided one page** letter describing your contributions to St John's College Residence life. You should discuss your participation in specific Residence and College activities and committees, indicating when you were involved. You may also wish to discuss your academic achievements.
- University of Manitoba transcripts will be obtained by the Awards Clerk: you do not need to submit them.
- Submit your completed application by the deadline to the Awards Clerk, St John's College, 92 Dysart Rd. Winnipeg, MB R3T 2M5.

Instructions if you are Nominating

- Nominator must live in St John's College Residence
- Nominee and Nominator complete and sign the application / nomination form.
- Include a **single sided one page** letter describing the nominee's contributions to St John's College Residence life. You should discuss in detail the nominee's participation in specific Residence and College activities and committees. You may also wish to discuss the nominee's academic achievements.
- You must get that nominee 's permission to submit the nomination. Please ask the nominee 's to read your nomination letter. Nominations that have not been signed by the nominee 's will not be considered.
- University of Manitoba transcripts will be obtained by the Awards Clerk: you do not need to submit them.
- Submit your completed nomination by the deadline to the Awards Clerk, St John's College, 92 Dysart Rd. Winnipeg, MB R3T 2M5.

Selection Process

Recipients will be selected by the Dean of Residence in consultation with the Residence Dons and Co-Presidents. The decision is subject to the approval of the St John's College Scholarship Committee. The selection committee may choose to select more than one recipient. Once a decision has been made, the Awards Clerk will write notification letters to recipients and alternates *only*. Please make sure your contact information on Aurora Student is kept up-to-date. The award will be applied to the recipient's second-term Residence fees at St John's College. If the recipient does not return to Residence or moves out before the bursary has been applied to his or her fees, the bursary will go to the alternate. Award certificates will be presented to recipients at the College Convocation on the first Sunday in November. The recipient's name will be printed in the College Convocation program and may be printed in the College's annual report and other publications. Award donors may be notified of the recipient's name and qualifications, and the recipient will be encouraged to send a thank-you note to the donor.
