Lab Safety Principles



Dress appropriately to enter the space. Wear pants and closed-toe shoes.



Follow all training and safe work procedures. Only conduct work you are trained to do.



Act in a manner that minimizes the risk of negative effects on people or the environment.



Wear all required and appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE).



Use all equipment for its intended use and operation only.



NO FOOD or DRINK allowed in the laboratory.



Always supervise all visitors to the lab.



Wash your hands before leaving the lab.



Be sure to follow the working alone plan for your lab.



Keep lab locked when unattended.



Report all incidents to your supervisor and EHSO.
