Fall 2022 Admission Requirement Update

The Department of Chemistry at the University of Manitoba has restructured its course offerings as of the Fall 2021 term. Included in these changes are the prerequisite introductory chemistry courses for admission to the School of Dental Hygiene Diploma program.

The updated required courses effective for the Fall 2022 intake, including the new Chemistry courses, are listed in the table below. ¹ The former CHEM 1300 and CHEM 1310 in combination can be used in lieu of CHEM 1100 and 1110 and 1120. Students having completed only CHEM 1300 must complete CHEM 1110 and 1120 to fulfill the Introductory Chemistry requirement.

² It is recommended that applicants take 6 credit hours of Introduction to Sociology as their elective. (University of Manitoba SOC 1200; University of Winnipeg SOC1101/6; Brandon University 90.154 and 90.155)
