STUDENT PUBLICATION POSITIONS

The **Manitoba Policy Perspective Journal** has a vacancy for a **Student Editor** to oversee the publication of one issue of the journal. The appointment is for 1 year with a stipend of \$2,500. The Editor will: conduct the final selection and editing of the paper submissions and coordinate the online publication of the journal; make applications to renew funding for the journal; provide progress reports to the Faculty Advisor, the Peer Review Board and to the Manitoba Inst. for Policy Research. The journal also has vacancies for volunteer **Peer Review Board Members**. These appointments are for 1 year with the possibility of renewal. The Board members will: be responsible for the selection and editing of papers; ensure the publication of the journal once a year; plan and execute a summer colloquium where published papers are presented; coordinate a marketing plan; communicate submission info to external groups; and they will work under the supervision of the Faculty Advisor. Applicants for both positions must be registered students at the UofM for both terms of the 2012/2013 academic year.
