



### Special Agreement for Entry and Working at Natural Resources Institute

I understand that the Natural Resources Institute is closed to the public and only through this special agreement with conditions am I able to gain access to work there.

I commit to follow the recommended behavior on an on-going basis to minimize the risk of transmission to myself, NRI colleagues and other University of Manitoba workers as set out below. I have initialized each condition below to show my commitment to abide by these behaviors recommended by public health.

Conditions required to always be adhered to.

**I commit to (check each box as applicable):**

Refrain from coming when sick or two weeks after travelling out of province or country.

Only enter through the NRI side-door (Sinnott wing) and refrain from entering St. Paul's College.

Wear a mask that covers my nose and mouth in all indoor common and shared spaces.  
*(Masks may be removed in individual offices, and in spaces when two-metre distancing can be maintained.)*

Work only at my designated workstation to ensure that there is no contamination of other work stations and sanitize my own work station.

Social distance from others by at least 2 metres.

Sanitize and disinfect any areas I touch.

Wash hands frequently.

Deposit any refuse in the corridor trash and recycle bins (i.e. not in your office garbage).

By signing this document, I recognize the risks from COVID-19 and am taking on the responsibility of precautionary measures to reduce my exposures at NRI. I note that if assigned a workstation at NRI during COVID-19, my admittance can be revoked at any time due to non-compliance with these requirements or changing COVID-19 scenarios.
