1. Direct Entry programs admit students directly from high school. Transit programs allow students to transit in automatically from University 1. (Arts/Science figures are separated into students who formally applied to Arts and Science and those who transited automatically from University 1). University Entry requires university study before application to the program. University Entry does not include special or visiting students.
2. Applicant data from the new application system, Apply Yourself, introduced in 2014-15.
3. Includes students who have accepted, or were offered, admission.
4. Registered status reflects data from end of term, in each year.
5. Effective July 1, 2015, the Faculty of Human Ecology's programs joined other academic units within the university. Students in Textile Sciences are now reported under the Faculty of Agricultural & Food Sciences. Students in Family Social Sciences are now reported under the Max Rady College of Medicine. Students in Health Sciences/Health Studies are now reported under the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences.
6. Excludes B.Mus./B.Ed. program.
7. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.
8. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.
9. Beginning in 2015, Nursing has split its intake, with a Fall Term intake of 120 students and a Winter Term intake of 120 students.
10. Within the UCN program, The Pas and Thompson sites each have a target of 20.
11. Students admitted to the joint program take their first-year courses at UCN. For that reason, the number registered is not shown.
12. Physical Education and Kinesiology have a combined quota of 100.
13. Law has five supernumerary places for half-time students and five supernumerary places for Indigenous students.
