1. Direct Entry programs admit students directly from high school. Transit programs allow students to transit in automatically from University 1. (Arts/Science figures are separated into students who formally applied to Arts and Science and those who transited automatically from University 1). University Entry requires university study before application to the program. University Entry does not include special or visiting students.
2. Applicant data from the new application system, Radius, introduced in 2017-18.
3. Includes students who have accepted, or were offered, admission.
4. Registered status reflects data from end of term, in each year.
5. Agricultural & Food Sciences target includes the target for Human Nutritional Sciences (90).
6. The Faculty of Health Sciences changed its name to the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences in 2016.
7. Beginning in 2017, the Rady Faculty of Health Sciences has an option for admission directly from high school.
8. The College of Dentistry changed its name to the Dr. Gerald Niznick College of Dentistry in 2018.
9. The College of Medicine changed its name to the Max Rady College of Medicine in 2016.
10. Admissions to Family Social Science programs suspended Fall 2019.
11. Nursing has a split intake, with a Fall Term intake of 120 students and a Winter Term intake of 120 students.
12. Within the UCN program, The Pas and Thompson sites each have a target of 20.
13. Students admitted to the joint program take their first-year courses at UCN. For that reason, the number registered is not shown.
14. This program no longer has an intake.
15. Beginning in Fall Term 2019, Pharmacy is transitioning to a new PharmD program. There was no intake in 2019.
16. Physical Education and Kinesiology have a combined target of 100.
17. Law has five supernumerary places for half-time students and five supernumerary places for Indigenous students.
