9. Beginning in Fall Term 2020, the Asper School of Business increased the number of students admitted each year.
10. Transfer credit programs for graduates of the Business Administration diploma programs at École technique et professionnelle (ÉTP), University College of the North (UCN), and Assiniboine (ACC) and Red River (RRC) Colleges.
11. The Faculty of Engineering changed its name to the Price Faculty of Engineering in 2020.
12. Includes students in General Studies and the diploma programs coordinated by Extended Education. Students enrolled in online, off campus, or distance education credit courses are shown in their faculty of registration.
13. Students in Certificate programs in Continuing Education, taking undergraduate courses.
14. The Ph.D. in Applied Health Sciences is offered jointly by Kinesiology and Recreation Management, Nursing, and Rehabilitation Sciences. Enrolment is reported under the Faculty of Graduate Studies.
15. B.Sc.(Dentistry) (Medicine) are second and third-year Dental and Medical students who registered for the B.Sc. programs in the summer term. Includes all students active in the program.
16. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there were no Medicine Externals in Winter Term 2022 or Winter Term 2021.
17. Students no longer admitted to the Family Social Sciences program within Max Rady College of Medicine, effective Fall Term 2019.
18. Post-Baccalaureate Diploma in Medical Physiology and Pathophysiology new in Fall Term 2021.
19. Postgraduate Medical Education students are physicians who have completed their undergraduate medical degree who are now registered in clinical residency programs.
20. Beginning in Fall Term 2021, enrolments include all University College of the North Cohort Nursing students as the University of Manitoba becomes the primary institution of record.
21. The new Bachelor of Midwifery program had its first intake in Fall Term 2021.
22. Pharmacy is transitioning from a B.Sc. Pharmacy to a PharmD program, beginning in Fall Term 2019.
23. The University 1 program was introduced in 1998-99. Most "new" students, with limited or no university experience, have registered under this program.
