2. Students are counted in one of three categories - Standard, Distance, or Combined. Standard delivery refers to traditional classroom instruction and includes Remote Learning course delivery, first introduced in Summer Term 2020.

Distance delivery includes Independent Study, on-line courses, and group-based study. Students taking a combination of Standard and Distance delivery are included in the Combined category.

4. Increase in enrolment in the College of Pharmacy is due to the transition from B.Sc. Pharmacy to PharmD program, beginning in Fall Term 2019.
