Fall Term Enrolment (as at November 1)

Summary Report

Fall Term Enrolment

As at the official reporting date of November 1, overall enrolment in Fall Term 2023 was 30,783 students, increasing 3.1%, from 29,844 students last year. The increase in enrolment in Fall Term 2023 was due mainly to an increase in the number of full-time students, bolstered by growth in the number of new students and expansions in health-related fields. Full-time enrolment increased 4.4%, from 25,661 students in Fall Term 2022 to 26,787 students in Fall Term 2023. Part-time enrolment decreased by 4.5%, from 4,183 students to 3,996 students.

Undergraduate enrolment increased by 3.4%, from 25,244 students in Fall Term 2022 to 26,114 students in Fall Term 2023. Graduate enrolment increased by 1.3%, from 3,914 students in Fall Term 2022 to 3,964 students in Fall Term 2023.

Credit Hours

Total undergraduate credit hours in Fall Term 2023 increased 3.7%. Credit hours in Fall Term 2023 were 277,594 compared to Fall Term 2022 credit hours of 267,811. Credit hours for courses offered through Distance and Online Education, excluding remote-learning, decreased 1.0%, from 33,600 credit hours to 33,252 credit hours.

International Students

International enrolment increased 5.9% overall, from 6,601 students last year to 6,991 students this year. As percentages of the student body, international students make up 20.8% of undergraduate students, 38.2% of graduate students, and 22.7% of the student population overall.

Indigenous Students

Self-declared Canadian Indigenous enrolment was up 4.2%, to 2,735 students in Fall Term 2023, from 2,625 students in Fall Term 2022. Indigenous students currently make up 9.4% of undergraduate students, 6.0% of graduate students, and 8.9% of the student population overall.
