2. Transfer credit program for graduates of the Agribusiness Diploma at Assiniboine Community College (ACC).
3. Transfer credit program for graduates of the Culinary Arts Diploma at Red River College (RRC).
4. St. Boniface students are included in headcounts when registered in courses at the University of Manitoba.
5. Beginning in Fall Term 2023, the Diploma program in the School of Art was revised to be a two-year program. Students admitted prior to Fall Term 2023 have the option to complete under the previous program.
6. Joint program (American Sign Language) with Red River College (RRC).
7. Reflects only those students enrolled in a Micro-Diploma who are not concurrently enrolled in another program; therefore, figures do not reflect total Micro-Diploma program enrolment.
8. Effective Fall Term 2024, the Diploma in Labour Relations and Workplace Studies is administered by the Faculty of Arts.
9. As at March 1 (Winter Term 2025), there were 103 Joint Master's Program students in the programs shared by the University of Manitoba and the University of Winnipeg (95 in Winter Term 2024). Based on workload calculations, the following JMPs have been reported under the University of Manitoba:

10. Transfer credit programs for graduates of the Business Administration diploma programs at École technique et professionnelle (ÉTP), University College of the North (UCN), and Assiniboine (ACC) and Red River (RRC) Colleges.
11. Includes students in General Studies and the diploma programs coordinated by Extended Education. Students enrolled in online, off campus, or distance education credit courses are shown in their faculty of registration.
