
OPENING OF ROBSON HALL

1. The Chairman will open the proceedings and request those present to sing "O Canada".
2. He will then call upon the Rev. W. G. Maclean to dedicate the building.
3. The President will call upon the Attorney-General of Manitoba to speak on behalf of the Government of Manitoba.
4. Dr. Saunderson will request Dean Edwards to lay the cornerstone.
5. The Chairman will introduce Mr. Justice Freedman, who will speak about the late Chief Justice Robson and Chief Justice Williams.
6. The President will request Mr. Hugh Robson to unveil the plaque naming the building, and
7. then request Mrs. Walter Hately, sister of Chief Justice Williams to unveil the plaque for the E. K. Williams Library.
8. The President will request The Lord High Chancellor of Great Britain to cut the ribbon and declare the building officially open.
9. The President will conclude the ceremonies by inviting those present to attend the reception in the building and will request them to join in singing "God Save the Queen".
