





**AVERAGE % OF CHILD CARE FUNDS RECEIVED FROM** PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT


Quality of care in children centres is improved with non-profit status as well as training levels. Province ranks #2 nationally in provincial care.

95% of all centres in Manitoba are not-for-profit.


2/3<sup>RD</sup> of child care centre staff must have post-secondary certification in Early Childhood Education.
