## **Terms of Reference**

### **Purpose**

The Student Experience Committee provides a forum for students and members of the University senior administration to review and discuss issues, programs, services, policies and procedures that will enhance the student experience at the University of Manitoba.

### **Composition**

Vice-Provost (Students), Chair  
Associate Vice-President (Administration)  
Director, Ancillary Services  
Associate Vice-President (Research)  
Vice-President (External) representative  
Two (2) Members, Student Affairs Leadership Team [appointed by the Vice-Provost (Students)]  
Three (3) Deans or Associate Deans [appointed by the Provost]  
Five (5) undergraduate students [appointed by UMSU]  
Two (2) graduate students [appointed by GSA]  
Two (2) undergraduate senior sticks [appointed by UMSU]

As requested, from time to time, additional people may be invited to attend Committee meetings to present information or act as resources.

### **Meetings**

Meetings of the Student Experience Committee will be held minimally four times a year. A minimum of two meetings per year will be held jointly with the President's Executive Team (PET). Agendas will be circulated a minimum of three days in advance of each meeting.

### **Reporting**

Recommendations on services, programs, policies and procedures will be forwarded to PET, UMSU, GSA, appropriate administrative units and/or appropriate University and student association governing bodies.
